AN ACT relating to counties; providing qualifications for the  
county offices of sheriff and constable; and providing  
other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** Chapter 248 of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
2     thereto a new section to read as follows:  
3     *No person is eligible to the office of sheriff unless:*  
4     1. *He will have attained the age of 21 years on the date he*  
5     *would take office if so elected;*  
6     2. *He is a qualified elector; and*  
7     3. *On or after January 1, 2006, he is certified by the Peace*  
8     *Officers' Standards and Training Commission created pursuant to*  
9     *NRS 289.500 as a Category I or Category II peace officer at the*  
10    *time he files his declaration of candidacy for the office of sheriff.*  
11    **Sec. 2.** Chapter 258 of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
12    thereto a new section to read as follows:  
13    *No person is eligible to the office of constable unless:*  
14    1. *He will have attained the age of 21 years on the date he*  
15    *would take office if so elected or appointed; and*
