AN ACT relating to pharmacy; prohibiting a pharmacist from refusing to fill or refill a prescription under certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 639 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows: 2

- 1. A pharmacist shall not refuse to fill or refill a prescription as written unless the pharmacist knows or has reasonable cause to believe that the prescription is:
  - (a) Fraudulent:

- (b) Issued contrary to law; or
- 7 8 (c) Contraindicated.
- 9 2. If a pharmacist refuses to dispense a prescription pursuant to paragraph (c) of subsection 1, the pharmacist shall consult with the prescribing practitioner as soon as practicable. 11
- 3. The provisions of this section do not: 12
  - (a) Require a pharmacist to stock a particular drug; or
- (b) Prohibit a pharmacist from: 14 15
  - (1) Substituting a drug pursuant to NRS 639.2583; or



- (2) Requiring payment for a drug in the normal course of
- business.

  4. A pharmacist is not subject to any penalty for violation of this section except as provided in NRS 639.255.
