AN ACT relating to public employees; increasing the salaries of certain forensic specialists employed by the State; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** 1. The Department of Personnel shall increase by
- 2     two grades the level of compensation on the pay plan for employees
- 3     in the classified service of the State that is adopted pursuant to NRS
- 4     284.175 for each person employed by the Department of
- 5     Corrections or the Division of Mental Health and Developmental
- 6     Services of the Department of Human Resources at Lakes Crossing
- 7     Center as a Forensic Specialist I, II, III or IV, effective retroactively
- 8     to January 1, 2003.
- 9     2. As used in this section, “grade” means the designation of a
- 10    salary range for a classification of employees.
- 11    **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2003.
