AN ACT making an appropriation to Clark County for the provision of mental health services in Laughlin; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to Clark County the sum of \$100,000 for disbursement to the Laughlin Family Resource Center for provision of contracted psychiatric and mental health care services to the residents of Laughlin.

6 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by 7 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after 8 June 30, 2005, and reverts to the State General Fund as soon as all 9 payments of money committed have been made.

10 Sec. 3. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
