AN ACT making supplemental appropriations to the Department of Motor Vehicles for certain unanticipated shortfalls in money for Fiscal Year 2002-2003; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
- 2 Highway Fund to the Automation Division of the Department of
- 3 Motor Vehicles the sum of \$667,590 for an unanticipated shortfall
- 4 in money for Fiscal Year 2002-2003 for the upgrade and expansion
- 5 of a toll-free telephone system. This appropriation is supplemental
- 6 to that made by section 30 of chapter 570, Statutes of Nevada 2001,
- 7 at page 2864.
- 8     2. There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund
- 9 to the Automation Division of the Department of Motor Vehicles
- 10 the sum of \$308,400 for an unanticipated shortfall in money for
- 11 Fiscal Year 2002-2003 for expenses relating to storage space for
- 12 discs. This appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 30
- 13 of chapter 570, Statutes of Nevada 2001, at page 2864.



1 3. There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund  
2 to the Hearings Office of the Department of Motor Vehicles the sum  
3 of \$44,200 for Fiscal Year 2002-2003 for an unanticipated shortfall  
4 in salaries and revenue. This appropriation is supplemental to that  
5 made by section 30 of chapter 570, Statutes of Nevada 2001, at page  
6 2864.

7 4. There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund  
8 to the Division of Field Services of the Department of Motor  
9 Vehicles the sum of \$30,419 for an unanticipated shortfall in money  
10 for Fiscal Year 2002-2003 for expenses relating to the Qmatic  
11 warranties. This appropriation is supplemental to that made by  
12 section 30 of chapter 570, Statutes of Nevada 2001, at page 2864.

13 5. There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund  
14 to the Division of Field Services of the Department of Motor  
15 Vehicles the sum of \$66,000 for an unanticipated shortfall in money  
16 for Fiscal Year 2002-2003 for rent for a building that is not owned  
17 by the State. This appropriation is supplemental to that made by  
18 section 30 of chapter 570, Statutes of Nevada 2001, at page 2864.

19 6. There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund  
20 to the Division of Compliance Enforcement of the Department of  
21 Motor Vehicles the sum of \$49,096 for an unanticipated shortfall in  
22 money for Fiscal Year 2002-2003 for fingerprinting services. This  
23 appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 30 of chapter  
24 570, Statutes of Nevada 2001, at page 2864.

25 7. There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund  
26 to the Division of Management Services and Programs of the  
27 Department of Motor Vehicles the sum of \$125,925 for an  
28 unanticipated shortfall in money for Fiscal Year 2002-2003 for  
29 salaries for security guards. This appropriation is supplemental to  
30 that made by section 30 of chapter 570, Statutes of Nevada 2001, at  
31 page 2864.

32 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
