# THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Consumer Affairs Division of the Department of Business and Industry the sum of \$9,238 for an unanticipated shortfall in money for Fiscal Year 2001-2002 resulting from outstanding vendor billings. This appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 23 of chapter 570, Statutes of Nevada 2001, at page 2862.
