AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Consumer Affairs Division of the Department of Business and Industry for an unanticipated shortfall in money for Fiscal Year 2001-2002; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General  
2 Fund to the Consumer Affairs Division of the Department of  
3 Business and Industry the sum of \$9,044 for an unanticipated  
4 shortfall in money for Fiscal Year 2001-2002 resulting from  
5 outstanding vendor billings. This appropriation is supplemental to  
6 that made by section 23 of chapter 570, Statutes of Nevada 2001, at  
7 page 2862.  
8     **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
