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AN ACT making an appropriation to the Governor for support of the Nevada Commission for National and Community Service; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State  
2 General Fund to the Governor the sum of \$300,000 to grant to the  
3 Nevada Commission for National and Community Service for use as  
4 matching money to obtain additional federal funding to continue its  
5 programs dedicated to promoting citizen volunteerism.  
6     2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1,  
7 the Nevada Commission for National and Community Service shall:  
8     (a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance  
9 Committee on or before December 15, 2004, that describes each  
10 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1  
11 from the date on which the money was received by the Nevada  
12 Commission for National and Community Service through  
13 December 1, 2004; and  
14     (b) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available  
15 to the Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims,



1 reports, vouchers or other records of information, confidential or  
2 otherwise of the Nevada Commission for National and Community  
3 Service regardless of their form or location, that the Legislative  
4 Auditor deems necessary to conduct an audit of the use of the  
5 money appropriated pursuant to subsection 1.

6 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by  
7 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after  
8 June 30, 2005, and reverts to the State General Fund as soon as all  
9 payments of money committed have been made.

10 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2003.
