AN ACT making an appropriation to Classroom on Wheels for the purchase of two buses to provide mobile school services for homeless children in Clark County; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to Classroom on Wheels the sum of \$100,000 for the purchase of two buses to provide mobile school services for homeless children in Clark County.

Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2005, and reverts to the State General Fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective on July 1, 2003.
