
ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 472—COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

MARCH 24, 2003

Referred to Committee on Ways and Means

SUMMARY—Makes appropriation to CHR, Inc., for operational costs and personnel expenses related to carrying out its program “Caring, Helping and Restoring Lives.” (BDR S-1321)

AN ACT making an appropriation to CHR, Inc., for operational costs and personnel expenses related to carrying out its program “Caring, Helping and Restoring Lives,” which assists dislocated workers; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
- 2 General Fund to CHR, Inc., the sum of \$350,000 for operational
- 3 costs and personnel expenses related to carrying out its program
- 4 “Caring, Helping and Restoring Lives,” which assists dislocated
- 5 workers.
- 6 2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1,
- 7 CHR, Inc., agrees to:
- 8 (a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance
- 9 Committee on or before December 15, 2004, that describes each
- 10 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1
- 11 from the date on which the money was received by the Alliance for
- 12 the Mentally Ill of Nevada through December 1, 2004; and
- 13 (b) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available
- 14 to the Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims,



1 reports, vouchers or other records of information, confidential or
2 otherwise and irrespective of their form or location, that the
3 Legislative Auditor deems necessary to conduct any audit of the use
4 of the money appropriated pursuant to subsection 1.

5 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
6 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
7 June 30, 2005, and reverts to the State General Fund as soon as all
8 payments of money committed have been made.

9 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2003.
