AN ACT relating to education; revising provisions governing the transferability of certain community college credits toward the requirements for an award of a baccalaureate degree from a university within the University and Community College System of Nevada; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** NRS 396.568 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2     396.568 In accordance with the policy of the Board of Regents,  
3 all credits earned by a student in a course at a community college  
4 within the System , *including, without limitation, all credits earned*  
5 *in a course toward the award of an associate's degree*, must be  
6 accepted and applied toward the course work required of the student  
7 in his major ~~or~~ *or minor*, if applicable, or other course work  
8 required of the student, for the award of a baccalaureate degree upon  
9 graduation of the student from any university within the System if  
10 the catalog for the community college:  
11     1. Designates the course as transferable by the System;  
12     2. Identifies the course by the same title as the equivalent  
13 required course offered at a university; and  
14     3. Contains the same description for the course as the  
15 equivalent required course offered at a university.



1     **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2003.
