AN ACT relating to the Division of Wildlife of the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources; authorizing the Division to charge a fee for advertising in printed materials prepared by the Division and for advertising on a website on the Internet that is maintained by the Division; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Chapter 501 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
 thereto a new section to read as follows:
- 3 1. The Division may charge fees for advertising:
- 4 (a) In printed materials prepared by the Division; and

5 (b) On a website on the Internet or its successor that is 6 maintained by the Division.

7 2. Any money collected by the Division pursuant to 8 subsection 1 must be:



1 (a) Deposited with the State Treasurer for credit to the Wildlife 2 Account in the State General Fund; and

3 (b) Used to pay the expenses of the Division including, without 4 limitation, expenses incurred in the development, production and 5 distribution of:

6 (1) Printed materials prepared by the Division;

7 (2) Materials used by the Division on the website 8 maintained by the Division; and

9 (3) Any informational and educational materials provided
