AN ACT relating to gaming; repealing the prohibition on the assignment of the right to periodic payments of winnings from gaming; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 463.3669 is hereby repealed.
- 2 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

TEXT OF REPEALED SECTION

463.3669 Assignment of right to periodic payments of winnings. No right of periodic payments of winnings is assignable by a patron, in whole or in part, except that periodic payments may be paid to the estate of a deceased patron or, pursuant to an order of dissolution of marriage entered by a court of competent jurisdiction, to the former spouse of a patron.
