- SUMMARY—Provides for issuance of special license plates for support of wildlife in Nevada. (BDR 43-332)

AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; providing for the issuance of special license plates for the support of wildlife in Nevada, including support for the programs and activities of the Nevada Wildlife Record Book Committee or its successor; imposing a fee for the issuance or renewal of such license plates; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 482 of NRS is hereby amended by adding 1 thereto a new section to read as follows: 2 1. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the 3 Department, in cooperation with the Nevada Wildlife Record Book 4 Committee or its successor, shall design, prepare and issue license 5 plates for the support of wildlife in Nevada, using any colors and 6 designs that the Department deems appropriate. The design of the 7 license plates must include a depiction of Nevada's desert bighorn 8 sheep (Ovis canadensis nelsoni). The Department shall not design, 9 prepare or issue the license plates unless it receives at least 1,000 10 applications for the issuance of those plates. 11 2. If the Department receives at least 1,000 applications for 12 13 the issuance of license plates for the support of wildlife in Nevada, 14 the Department shall issue those plates for a passenger car or light

15 commercial vehicle upon application by a person who is entitled to



license plates pursuant to NRS 482.265 and who otherwise 1 complies with the requirements for registration and licensing 2 pursuant to this chapter. A person may request that personalized 3 prestige license plates issued pursuant to NRS 482.3667 be 4 5 combined with license plates for the support of wildlife in Nevada if that person pays the fees for the personalized prestige license 6 7 plates in addition to the fees for the license plates for the support 8 of wildlife in Nevada pursuant to subsections 3 and 4. 9 3. The fee for license plates for the support of wildlife in

Nevada is \$35, in addition to all other applicable registration and
license fees and governmental services taxes. The license plates
are renewable upon the payment of \$10.

13 4. In addition to all fees for the license, registration and 14 governmental services taxes, a person who requests a set of license 15 plates for the support of wildlife in Nevada must pay for the initial issuance of the plates an additional fee of \$25 and for each 16 renewal of the plates an additional fee of \$20 to finance projects 17 for the support of wildlife in Nevada, including, without limitation, 18 19 the establishment, maintenance and support of an interpretive 20 center relating to wildlife in this state.

5. The Department shall deposit the fees collected pursuant to
 subsection 4 with the State Treasurer for credit to the Account for
 License Plates for the Support of Wildlife in Nevada created
 pursuant to section 4 of this act.

25 6. If, during a registration year, the holder of license plates 26 issued pursuant to the provisions of this section disposes of the 27 vehicle to which the plates are affixed, the holder shall:

(a) Retain the plates and affix them to another vehicle that
 meets the requirements of this section if the holder pays the fee for
 the transfer of the registration and any registration fee or

31 governmental services tax due pursuant to NRS 482.399; or

(b) Within 30 days after removing the plates from the vehicle,
return them to the Department.

34 Sec. 2. NRS 482.216 is hereby amended to read as follows:

482.216 1. Upon the request of a new vehicle dealer, theDepartment may authorize the new vehicle dealer to:

(a) Accept applications for the registration of the new motorvehicles he sells and the related fees and taxes;

(b) Issue certificates of registration to applicants who satisfy therequirements of this chapter; and

41 (c) Accept applications for the transfer of registration pursuant 42 to NRS 482.399 if the applicant purchased from the new vehicle 43 dealer a new vehicle to which the registration is to be transferred.

44 2. A new vehicle dealer who is authorized to issue certificates 45 of registration pursuant to subsection 1 shall:

A new vehicle dealer who is authorized to issue certificates 11 of registration pursuant to subsection 1 shall not: 12 13 (a) Charge any additional fee for the performance of those 14 services: (b) Receive compensation from the Department for the 15 16 performance of those services; (c) Accept applications for the renewal of registration of a motor 17 18 vehicle: or (d) Accept an application for the registration of a motor vehicle 19 20 if the applicant wishes to: (1) Obtain special license plates pursuant to NRS 482.3667 21 22 to 482.3825, inclusive [;], and section 1 of this act; or (2) Claim the exemption from the governmental services tax 23 provided pursuant to NRS 361.1565 to veterans and their relations. 24 25 4. The Director shall adopt such regulations as are necessary to 26 carry out the provisions of this section. The regulations adopted 27 pursuant to this subsection must provide for: 28 (a) The expedient and secure issuance of license plates and 29 decals by the Department; and (b) The withdrawal of the authority granted to a new vehicle 30 dealer pursuant to subsection 1 if that dealer fails to comply with the 31 regulations adopted by the Department. 32 Sec. 3. NRS 482.500 is hereby amended to read as follows: 33 34 482.500 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2 or 3, whenever upon application any duplicate or substitute certificate of 35 registration, decal or number plate is issued, the following fees must 36 37 be paid: 38 39 For a certificate of registration......\$5.00 40 For every substitute number plate or set of plates...... 5.00 41 For every duplicate number plate or set of plates 10.00 42 43 For every other decal, license plate sticker or tab...... 5.00



(a) Transmit the applications he receives to the Department

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1 2. The following fees must be paid for any replacement plate or 2 set of plates issued for the following special license plates:

3 (a) For any special plate issued pursuant to NRS 482.3667, 4 482.3672, 482.3675, 482.370 to 482.376, inclusive, or 482.379 to 5 482.3816, inclusive, *and section 1 of this act*, a fee of \$10.

6 (b) For any special plate issued pursuant to NRS 482.368, 7 482.3765, 482.377 or 482.378, a fee of \$5.

8 (c) Except as otherwise provided in NRS 482.37937 and 9 482.37945, for any souvenir license plate issued pursuant to NRS 10 482.3825 or sample license plate issued pursuant to NRS 482.2703, 11 a fee equal to that established by the Director for the issuance of 12 those plates.

13 3. A fee must not be charged for a duplicate or substitute of a 14 decal issued pursuant to NRS 482.37635.

4. The fees which are paid for duplicate number plates and
decals displaying county names must be deposited with the State
Treasurer for credit to the Motor Vehicle Fund and allocated to the
Department to defray the costs of duplicating the plates and
manufacturing the decals.

5. As used in this section:

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(a) "Duplicate number plate" means a license plate or a set of
license plates issued to a registered owner which repeat the code of
a plate or set of plates previously issued to the owner to maintain his
registration using the same code.

(b) "Substitute number plate" means a license plate or a set of license plates issued in place of a previously issued and unexpired plate or set of plates. The plate or set of plates does not repeat the code of the previously issued plate or set.

29 Sec. 4. Chapter 232 of NRS is hereby amended by adding 30 thereto a new section to read as follows:

I. The Account for License Plates for the Support of Wildlife
 in Nevada is hereby created in the State General Fund. The
 Administrator shall administer the Account.

2. The money in the Account does not lapse to the State
General Fund at the end of a fiscal year. The interest and income
earned on the money in the Account, after deducting any
applicable charges, must be credited to the Account.

38 **3.** The money in the Account:

(a) Must be used for the support of wildlife in Nevada,
including, without limitation, the establishment, maintenance and
support of an interpretive center regarding wildlife in this state;
and

43 (b) Must not be used to replace or supplant funding available 44 from other sources.



4. The Administrator may provide grants from the Account to
 other public agencies to carry out the provisions of this section.
 5. As used in this section, "Administrator" means the

4 Administrator of the Division of Wildlife appointed pursuant to 5 NRS 232.138.

6 Sec. 5. NRS 232.010 is hereby amended to read as follows:

7 232.010 As used in NRS 232.010 to 232.150, inclusive [;], 8 and section 4 of this act, unless the context otherwise requires:

9 1. "Department" means the State Department of Conservation 10 and Natural Resources.

2. "Director" means the Director of the [State Department of
 Conservation and Natural Resources.] Department.

13 Sec. 6. On or before October 1, 2005, the Department of 14 Motor Vehicles shall determine and publicly declare the number of 15 applications it has received for the issuance of license plates 16 pursuant to section 1 of this act.

17 Sec. 7. The amendatory provisions of this act expire by 18 limitation on October 1, 2005, if on that date the Department of 19 Motor Vehicles has received fewer than 1,000 applications for the 20 issuance of license plates pursuant to section 1 of this act.
