AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Education for revision of the test-taking and grading sections of the multiple-choice portion of the high school proficiency examination; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Department of Education the sum of \$3,000,000 for revision of the test-taking and grading sections of the multiple-choice portion of the high school proficiency examination to make use of technology that is similar to the technology used to test classroom performance.
