AN ACT relating to industrial insurance; clarifying the coverage of industrial insurance for members of the Nevada Legislature; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 616A.185 is hereby amended to read as 2 follows:

3 616A.185 For the purposes of chapters 616A to 616D, 4 inclusive, of NRS:

5 **1.** A member of the Nevada Legislature shall be deemed [for 6 the purposes of chapters 616A to 616D, inclusive, of NRS] to be an 7 employee of the State during his term of office at the wage of 8 \$2,000 per month and is entitled to the benefits of those chapters.

9 2. A member of the Nevada Legislature shall be deemed to be 10 acting in the course of his employment as a Legislator if, at the 11 time of the injury, he was performing any act or was engaging in any function that was reasonably related to his legislative office, 12 his public service as a Legislator or his political activities as a 13 14 Legislator, whether or not he was being compensated by the State for performing the act or engaging in the function at the time of 15 the injury. Such acts and functions include, without limitation: 16 (a) Attending, as a Legislator, a function, event, seminar, 17 18 conference, hearing, meeting or gathering of a public body at the



federal, state or local level for purposes relating to law, policy,
politics or issues of public concern.

3 (b) Attending, as a Legislator, a public, private or political 4 function, event, seminar, conference, hearing, meeting or

5 gathering for purposes relating to law, policy, politics or issues of 6 public concern.

7 (c) Meeting, as a Legislator, with constituents or other persons 8 for purposes relating to law, policy, politics or issues of public 9 concern.

10 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
