SUMMARY—Requires transfer of money from Fund for School Improvement to University and Community College System of Nevada to provide scholarships for students pursuing degrees in teaching. (BDR S-1033)

AN ACT relating to education; requiring the transfer of money from the Fund for School Improvement to the University and Community College System of Nevada to provide scholarships for students pursuing degrees in teaching; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** The Superintendent of Public Instruction shall
- 2 transfer from the Fund for School Improvement created by NRS
- 3 387.032 to the University and Community College System of
- 4 Nevada the sum of \$230,680 to be distributed as follows:
- 5 1. For the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, and the University
- 6 of Nevada, Reno, the sum of \$130,680 to be used to provide not
- 7 more than 45 scholarships at each University for qualified students
- 8 pursuing degrees in teaching; and
- 9 2. For the Great Basin College and Nevada State College,
- 10 Henderson, the sum of \$100,000 to be used to provide not more



1 than 45 scholarships at each College for qualified students pursuing
2 degrees in teaching.

3 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the sum authorized for
4 expenditure by section 1 of this act must not be committed for
5 expenditure after June 30, 2005, and reverts to the Fund for School
6 Improvement as soon as all payments of money committed have
7 been made.

8 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
