AN ACT relating to employment; reducing the minimum number of employees that an employer must have to be subject to the provisions prohibiting unlawful employment practices; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. NRS 613.310 is hereby amended to read as follows: 613.310 As used in NRS 613.310 to 613.435, inclusive, unless the context otherwise requires:

- 1. "Disability" means, with respect to a person:
- 5 (a) A physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one 6 or more of the major life activities of the person;
 - (b) A record of such an impairment; or
 - (c) Being regarded as having such an impairment.
 - 2. "Employer" means any person who has [15] *five* or more employees for each working day in each of 20 or more calendar weeks in the current or preceding calendar year, but does not include:
- 13 (a) The United States or any corporation wholly owned by the United States.
- 15 (b) Any Indian tribe.

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16 (c) Any private membership club exempt from taxation pursuant to 26 U.S.C. § 501(c).



3. "Employment agency" means any person regularly undertaking with or without compensation to procure employees for an employer or to procure for employees opportunities to work for an employer, but does not include any agency of the United States.

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4. "Labor organization" means any organization of any kind, or any agency or employee representation committee or plan, in which employees participate and which exists for the purpose, in whole or in part, of dealing with employers concerning grievances, labor disputes, wages, rates of pay, hours of employment or other conditions of employment.

5. "Person" includes the State of Nevada and any of its political subdivisions.

6. "Sexual orientation" means having or being perceived as having an orientation for heterosexuality, homosexuality or bisexuality.
