AN ACT relating to lobbyists; prohibiting a lobbyist from requesting certain services from an employee of the Legislative Counsel Bureau without authorization from a Legislator; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 218 of NRS is hereby amended by adding 1 2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, a lobbyist 4 shall not request that an employee of the Legislative Counsel Bureau provide professional services for the lobbyist. 5

2. A Legislator may authorize a lobbyist to request 6 professional services on behalf of the Legislator from an employee 7 of the Legislative Counsel Bureau. The authorization must be in 8 9

writing and must specify the nature and extent of the services that

10 the lobbyist may request. The lobbyist shall not seek services other 11

than those specified in the written authorization.



3. The Director shall develop a form for use by Legislators in authorizing a lobbyist to request professional services pursuant to 1 2 subsection 2. 3

4. As used in this section, "professional services" means conducting, on behalf of a Legislator, legal, fiscal or policy 4 5 6

research or analysis, drafting a bill, resolution or amendment, or otherwise engaging in work for which an employee is professionally trained or qualified. 7 8
