AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Supreme Court of Nevada for an unanticipated shortfall in money for Fiscal Year 2002-2003 resulting from a deficit in the collection of administrative assessments; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Supreme Court of Nevada the sum of \$500,748 for an unanticipated shortfall in money for Fiscal Year 2002-2003 resulting from a deficit in the collection of administrative assessments. This appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 11 of chapter 570, Statutes of Nevada 2001, at page 2858. **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
