SUMMARY—Makes various changes concerning drivers’ licenses issued to persons under 18 years of age. (BDR 43-714)

AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; making various changes concerning the issuance of drivers’ licenses to persons who are 16 or 17 years of age; revising certain restrictions relating to the transportation of passengers who are under 18 years of age; providing that the parent or legal guardian of a person who commits certain violations with respect to the operation of a motor vehicle is liable to pay the fine or penalties imposed for such a violation and may be required to perform community service if unable to pay the fine or penalties; revising provisions relating to automobile driver education in public schools; providing penalties; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.



THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** Chapter 483 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto the provisions set forth as sections 2 to 6, inclusive, of this
3 act.
- 4 **Sec. 2. 1.** *The Department may issue a driver's license to a*
5 *person who is 16 or 17 years of age if:*
- 6 (a) *Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, he has*
7 *completed a course:*
- 8 (1) *In automobile driver education pursuant to NRS*
9 *389.090; or*
- 10 (2) *Provided by a school for training drivers which is*
11 *licensed pursuant to NRS 483.700 to 483.780, inclusive, and*
12 *which complies with the applicable regulations governing the*
13 *establishment, conduct and scope of automobile driver education*
14 *adopted by the State Board of Education pursuant to*
15 *NRS 389.090;*
- 16 (b) *He has at least 50 hours of supervised experience in*
17 *driving a motor vehicle with a restricted license, instruction permit*
18 *or restricted instruction permit issued pursuant to NRS 483.267,*
19 *483.270 or 483.280, including, without limitation, at least 10 hours*
20 *of experience in driving a motor vehicle during darkness;*
- 21 (c) *He submits to the Department a form provided by the*
22 *Department that is signed:*
- 23 (1) *By his parent or legal guardian; or*
- 24 (2) *If the person applying for the driver's license is an*
25 *emancipated minor, by a licensed driver who is at least 21 years of*
26 *age or by a licensed driving instructor,*
27 *which attests that the person applying for the driver's license has*
28 *completed the training and experience required pursuant to*
29 *paragraphs (a) and (b);*
- 30 (d) *He has not been found to be responsible for a motor*
31 *vehicle accident during the 6 months before he applies for the*
32 *driver's license;*
- 33 (e) *He has not been convicted of a moving traffic violation or a*
34 *crime involving alcohol or a controlled substance during the 6*
35 *months before he applies for the driver's license; and*
- 36 (f) *He has held an instruction permit for not less than 6*
37 *months before he applies for the driver's license.*
- 38 **2.** *A person who is 16 or 17 years of age and who:*
- 39 (a) *Resides in a county whose population is less than 50,000 or*
40 *in a city or town whose population is less than 25,000; and*



1 ***(b) Is not enrolled in a school or is enrolled in a school that***
2 ***does not offer automobile driver education,***
3 ***is not required to complete a course as required pursuant to***
4 ***paragraph (a) of subsection 1.***

5 **Sec. 3. 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, a**
6 ***person to whom a driver's license is issued pursuant to section 2 of***
7 ***this act shall not, during the first 6 months after the date on which***
8 ***the driver's license is issued, transport as a passenger a person***
9 ***who is under 18 years of age.***

10 **2. A person to whom a driver's license is issued pursuant to**
11 ***section 2 of this act may transport as a passenger a member of his***
12 ***immediate family, regardless of the age of the family member.***

13 **3. If the parent or legal guardian of a person to whom a**
14 ***driver's license is issued pursuant to section 2 of this act***
15 ***knowingly and willfully allows the person to operate a motor***
16 ***vehicle in violation of this section, the parent or legal guardian is***
17 ***liable for all fines and penalties imposed against the person. If the***
18 ***parent or legal guardian is unable to pay the fine and penalties***
19 ***resulting from a violation of this section because of financial***
20 ***hardship, the court may require the parent or legal guardian to***
21 ***perform community service.***

22 **Sec. 4. 1. A peace officer shall not stop a motor vehicle for**
23 ***the sole purpose of determining whether the driver is violating a***
24 ***provision of section 3 of this act. A citation may be issued for a***
25 ***violation of section 3 of this act only if the violation is discovered***
26 ***when the vehicle is halted or its driver arrested for another alleged***
27 ***violation or offense.***

28 **2. A violation of section 3 of this act:**

29 ***(a) Is not a moving traffic violation pursuant to NRS 483.473;***
30 ***and***

31 ***(b) Is not grounds for suspension or revocation of the driver's***
32 ***license pursuant to NRS 483.360.***

33 **Sec. 5. The Department may:**

34 **1. With respect to a driver's license that is issued pursuant to**
35 ***section 2 of this act:***

36 ***(a) Include on the face of the license the original date on***
37 ***which the license was issued; or***

38 ***(b) Otherwise indicate that the license is for use by a person***
39 ***who:***

40 ***(1) Is 16 or 17 years of age; and***

41 ***(2) Satisfied the requirements set forth in section 2 of this***
42 ***act before receiving the license;***

43 **2. Issue drivers' licenses pursuant to section 2 of this act with**
44 ***distinguishing characteristics which clearly indicate that the***
45 ***licensee is 16 or 17 years of age; and***



1 **3. Adopt regulations necessary to carry out the laws**
2 **governing the issuance of drivers' licenses pursuant to section 2 of**
3 **this act.**

4 **Sec. 6. If the driver's license of a person who is under 18**
5 **years of age is restricted or suspended as a result of an act**
6 **committed in violation of sections 2 to 6, inclusive, of this act, the**
7 **restriction or suspension remains in effect until the end of the**
8 **term of the restriction or suspension even if the person becomes 18**
9 **years of age before the end of the term of the restriction or**
10 **suspension.**

11 **Sec. 7.** NRS 483.250 is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 483.250 The Department shall not issue any license pursuant to
13 the provisions of NRS 483.010 to 483.630, inclusive:

14 1. To any person who is under the age of 18 years, except that
15 the Department may issue:

16 (a) A restricted license to a person between the ages of 14 and
17 18 years pursuant to the provisions of NRS 483.267 and 483.270.

18 (b) An instruction permit to a person who is at least 15 1/2 years
19 of age pursuant to the provisions of subsection 1 of NRS 483.280.

20 (c) A restricted instruction permit to a person under the age of
21 18 years pursuant to the provisions of subsection 3 of NRS 483.280.

22 (d) ~~Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (e), a license to a~~
23 ~~person between the ages of 15 3/4 and 18 years if:~~

24 ~~(1) He has completed a course:~~

25 ~~(I) In automobile driver education pursuant to NRS~~
26 ~~389.090; or~~

27 ~~(II) Provided by a school for training drivers licensed~~

34 2. To any person whose license has been revoked until the
35 expiration of the period during which he is not eligible for a license.

36 3. To any person whose license has been suspended, but upon
37 good cause shown to the Administrator, the Department may issue a
38 restricted license to him or shorten any period of suspension.

39 4. To any person who has previously been adjudged to be
40 afflicted with or suffering from any mental disability or disease and
41 who has not at the time of application been restored to legal
42 capacity.

43 5. To any person who is required by NRS 483.010 to 483.630,
44 inclusive, to take an examination, unless he has successfully passed
45 the examination.



1 6. To any person when the Administrator has good cause to
2 believe that by reason of physical or mental disability that person
3 would not be able to operate a motor vehicle safely.

4 7. To any person who is not a resident of this state.

5 8. To any child who is the subject of a court order issued
6 pursuant to paragraph (h) of subsection 1 of NRS 62.211, NRS
7 62.2255, 62.226 or 62.228 which delays his privilege to drive.

8 9. To any person who is the subject of a court order issued
9 pursuant to NRS 206.330 which suspends or delays his privilege to
10 drive until the expiration of the period of suspension or delay.

11 **Sec. 8.** NRS 483.255 is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 483.255 The Department shall adopt regulations that set forth
13 the number of hours of training which a person whose age is less
14 than 18 years must complete in a course provided by a school for
15 training drivers to be issued a *driver's* license pursuant to
16 subparagraph (2) of paragraph ~~[(d)]~~ (a) of subsection 1 of ~~[NRS~~
17 ~~483.250.]~~ **section 2 of this act.** The regulations must require that the
18 number of hours that must be completed by such a person be
19 comparable to the number of hours of instruction which would be
20 required of such a person if he completed his training in a course
21 provided pursuant to NRS 389.090.

22 **Sec. 9.** NRS 483.620 is hereby amended to read as follows:

23 483.620 It is a misdemeanor for any person to violate any of
24 the provisions of NRS 483.010 to 483.630, inclusive, **and sections 2**
25 **to 6, inclusive, of this act**, unless such violation is, by NRS 483.010
26 to 483.630, inclusive, **and sections 2 to 6, inclusive, of this act** or
27 other law of this state, declared to be a felony.

28 **Sec. 10.** NRS 484.466 is hereby amended to read as follows:

29 484.466 **I.** A person shall not operate a motor vehicle in a
30 jurisdiction during any time when he is in violation of a curfew in
31 the jurisdiction.

32 **2.** *If the parent or legal guardian of a person under the age of*
33 *18 years knowingly and willfully allows the person to operate a*
34 *motor vehicle in violation of this section, the parent or legal*
35 *guardian is liable for all fines and penalties imposed against the*
36 *person. If the parent or legal guardian is unable to pay the fine*
37 *and penalties resulting from a violation of this section because of*
38 *financial hardship, the court may require the parent or legal*
39 *guardian to perform community service.*

40 **Sec. 11.** NRS 389.090 is hereby amended to read as follows:

41 389.090 **1.** The State Board shall adopt regulations governing
42 the establishment, conduct and scope of automobile driver education
43 in the public schools of this state. The regulations must set forth,
44 without limitation:



- 1 (a) The number of hours of training that must be completed by a
2 pupil who enrolls in a course in automobile driver education;
3 (b) That a course in automobile driver education ~~may be~~ :
4 (1) **Must include a component of training** conducted in a
5 classroom ~~for~~; and
6 (2) **May, in addition to the component of training**
7 **conducted in a classroom, include a component of training**
8 **conducted in a motor vehicle ; ~~or both;~~** and
9 (c) That if a course in automobile driver education ~~is~~ **includes**
10 **components of training** conducted both in a classroom and in a
11 motor vehicle ~~;~~ :
12 (1) **One** hour of training in a motor vehicle is equivalent to 3
13 hours of training in a classroom ~~;~~; and
14 (2) **Not more than one-half of the required number of**
15 **hours of training described in paragraph (a) may be training in a**
16 **motor vehicle.**
17 2. The aims and purposes of automobile driver education are to
18 develop the knowledge, attitudes, habits and skills necessary for the
19 safe operation of motor vehicles.
20 3. The board of trustees of a school district may establish and
21 maintain courses in automobile driver education during regular
22 semesters and summer sessions and during the regular school day
23 and at times other than during the regular school day for:
24 (a) Pupils enrolled in the regular full-time day high schools in
25 the school district.
26 (b) Pupils enrolled in summer classes conducted in high schools
27 in the school district.
28 A board of trustees maintaining courses in automobile driver
29 education shall insure against any liability arising out of the use of
30 motor vehicles in connection with those courses. The cost of the
31 insurance must be paid from available money of the school district.
32 4. A governing body of a charter school may establish and
33 maintain courses in automobile driver education if the governing
34 body insures against any liability arising out of the use of motor
35 vehicles in connection with those courses.
36 5. Automobile driver education must be provided by boards of
37 trustees of school districts and governing bodies of charter schools
38 in accordance with the regulations of the State Board and may not
39 be duplicated by any other agency, department, commission or
40 officer of the State of Nevada.
41 6. Each course in automobile driver education provided by a
42 board of trustees of a school district or a governing body of a charter
43 school must include, without limitation, instruction in:
44 (a) Motor vehicle insurance.



1 (b) The effect of drugs and alcohol on an operator of a motor
2 vehicle.

3 7. Each course in automobile driver education provided by a
4 board of trustees of a school district or a governing body of a charter
5 school must be restricted to pupils who are at least 15 years of age.

6 **Sec. 12.** NRS 483.253 is hereby repealed.

7 **Sec. 13.** The provisions of sections 2 to 5, inclusive, and 7 of
8 this act do not apply to a person who has been issued a driver's
9 license before October 1, 2003.

TEXT OF REPEALED SECTION

483.253 Restrictions on transporting passengers who are under 18 years of age; exception for members of immediate family.

1. If a person is under the age of 16 years on the date on which the Department issues a license to him pursuant to NRS 483.250, he shall not, during the 90 days immediately succeeding the date on which the Department issues that license, transport as a passenger in a motor vehicle that he is driving any person under the age of 18 years unless that passenger is a member of his immediate family.

2. If a person is 16 years of age or older but less than 17 years of age on the date on which the Department issues a license to him pursuant to NRS 483.250, he shall not, during the 60 days immediately succeeding the date on which the Department issues that license, transport as a passenger in a motor vehicle that he is driving any person under the age of 18 years unless that passenger is a member of his immediate family.

3. If a person is 17 years of age or older but less than 18 years of age on the date on which the Department issues a license to him pursuant to NRS 483.250, he shall not, during the 30 days immediately succeeding the date on which the Department issues that license, transport as a passenger in a motor vehicle that he is driving any person under the age of 18 years unless that passenger is a member of his immediate family.
