AN ACT relating to health care; prohibiting a public hospital from charging a fee that is below the cost of providing a service to a patient who is not indigent; providing that certain information on costs for services provided by public hospitals is public; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 450 of NRS is hereby amended by adding 2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 1. Any fee, rate or charge for a service rendered by or 4 through a facility of a public hospital to a patient who is not 5 indigent must be equal to or greater than the total cost of the 6 service.

7 2. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a public 8 hospital shall make information concerning the total cost of a 9 service provided by a facility of the public hospital to a patient who is not indigent public and open to inspection pursuant to the 10 provisions of NRS 239.010. A public hospital shall not make 11 public the name of, or other personal identifying information 12 about, a person pursuant to this subsection. 13 3. As used in this section "total cost of the service" means the 14

15 full direct costs and allocated indirect costs associated with the



provision of the service consistent with generally accepted 1 accounting principles. These costs include, without limitation, costs incurred for salaries, contract labor, employee benefits, 2 3 supplies, professional fees, repairs and maintenance, rents and 4 leases, utilities, insurance, bad debt, taxes and other operating 5 expenses. 6 Sec. 2. NRS 450.010 is hereby amended to read as follows: 7 450.010 For the purposes of NRS 450.010 to 450.510, 8 inclusive, and section 1 of this act "taxpayers" include only citizens of the United States of the age of 18 years and upward who, at the 9 10 time of filing their petition, are registered electors of the county in 11 which an election is proposed to be held and whose names appear 12 on the latest assessment roll of the county as owners of real or

13 on the latest assessment roll of the co14 personal property.

15 Sec. 3. This act becomes effective on July 1, 2003.
