AN ACT relating to statutory construction; abolishing Dillon's Rule concerning statutory interpretation of the powers of a local government; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The preliminary chapter of NRS is hereby amended 1 2 by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

1. For the purpose of interpreting a statute relating to the 3 powers of a local government, a local government has such 4 5 powers as are: 6

(a) Granted in express words;

7 (b) Necessarily or fairly implied in or incident to the powers 8 expressly granted; or

0 (c) Appropriate or convenient to the accomplishment of the 10 declared objects and purposes of the local government,

11 unless otherwise limited by specific statute.

2. The purpose of this section is to abolish Dillon's Rule in 12

13 this state.



1 3. This section does not authorize a local government to 2 impose or increase a tax unless the tax or increase is otherwise 3 authorized by specific statute.
