AN ACT relating to the Nevada National Guard; revising the provisions governing the educational benefits provided to members of the Nevada National Guard; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** NRS 412.143 is hereby amended to read as follows: 1 2 412.143 1. The Adjutant General may authorize the payment of [no more than] up to 100 percent of the [consolidated fee] 3 registration fees and laboratory fees each semester [for] on behalf of each member of the active Nevada National Guard, including, 4 5 without limitation, a recruit, who attends [one of the universities] a 7 school within the University and Community College System of 8 Nevada as a full-time or part-time student from money appropriated Q for **[this purpose.** 2. The Adjutant General may authorize the payment of no more 10 than 100 percent of the credit-hour cost each semester for each 11 member of the active Nevada National Guard who attends one of the 12 13 community colleges within the University and Community College 14 System of Nevada as a full-time or part-time student from money appropriated for this purpose. 15 3. that purpose. 16



- 2. The payments authorized by subsection 1 must not be made on behalf of any person for more than 36 months.
- 3. To be eligible [to receive benefits,] for the payments authorized by subsection 1, a person must [be]:
- (a) Be a member in good standing of the active Nevada National Guard, including, without limitation, a recruit, at the beginning of and throughout the entire semester for which [benefits are received.] payments are made; and
- (b) Maintain at least a 2.0 grade-point average, on a 4.0 grading scale, each semester, or the equivalent of a 2.0 gradepoint average if a different grading scale is used.
- 4. If the payments authorized by subsection 1 are made on behalf of a recruit and the recruit does not enter full-time National Guard duty within 1 year after enlisting, the recruit must reimburse the Adjutant General for all such payments made on behalf of the recruit if his failure to enter full-time National Guard duty is attributable to his own conduct.

- (a) "Full-time National Guard duty" has the meaning ascribed 19 20 to it in 32 U.S.C § 101(19).
- (b) "Recruit" means a person who has enlisted in the Nevada 21 National Guard but has not begun his required military training. 22 23
  - **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2003.
