AN ACT relating to tobacco; prohibiting the placing of a cigarette vending machine where a minor is permitted to loiter; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 202.2494 is hereby amended to read as
2 follows:

3 202.2494 1. A cigarette vending machine must not be placed
4 in a public area ~~{described in paragraph (a), (c), (e), (f), (g) or (h) of~~
5 ~~subsection 1 of NRS 202.2491,}~~ if minors are permitted ~~{access}~~ to
6 *loiter in* that area.

7 2. A coin-operated vending machine containing cigarettes must
8 not be used to dispense any product not made from tobacco.
