AN ACT relating to public health; designating the Nevada Cancer Institute as the official cancer institute of the State of Nevada; making an appropriation; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 457 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

The Nevada Cancer Institute is hereby designated as the official cancer institute of the State of Nevada.

- **Sec. 2.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, the sum of \$1,500,000 for the creation of the infrastructure needed to establish an oral cancer and forensic institute.
- 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2005, and reverts to the State General Fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.
- **Sec. 3.** 1. This section and section 1 of this act becomes effective upon passage and approval.



2. Section 2 of this act becomes effective on July 1, 2003.
