AN ACT relating to traffic laws; revising the penalty for certain violations concerning vehicles with loads on highways; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** NRS 484.771 is hereby amended to read as follows: 484.771 1. No vehicle [shall] with a load may be driven or moved on any highway unless [such] the vehicle is [so] constructed or loaded so as to prevent any of its load from dropping, sifting, leaking or otherwise escaping [therefrom,] from the vehicle, except that sand may be dropped for the purpose of securing traction, or water or any other substance may be sprinkled on a roadway in cleaning or maintaining [such] the roadway.

- 2. [No] A person shall **not** operate on [any] a highway any vehicle with [any] a load unless the load and any covering thereon is securely fastened so as to prevent the covering or load from becoming loose, detached or in any manner a hazard to other users of the highway.
- 3. A person who violates this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$25 per violation.
