AN ACT relating to the Legislature; naming the Legislative Building after former Senator Lawrence E. Jacobsen; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

1 WHEREAS, Lawrence E. Jacobsen served in the Nevada
2 Legislature for 40 years, longer than any other Legislator in the
3 history of this state, including 16 years in the Assembly and 24
4 years in the Senate; and

5 WHEREAS, While in the Assembly, Lawrence Jacobsen chaired
6 the Legislative Commission during the construction of the
7 Legislative Building, then served as Speaker of the Assembly for the
8 first session held in the building in 1971; and

9 WHEREAS, While in the Senate, Senator Jacobsen served on the
10 committee that planned the major expansion and renovation of the
11 Legislative Building in 1997; and

12 WHEREAS, Senator Jacobsen always devoted a substantial
13 amount of time and attention to the maintenance and improvement
14 of the Legislative Building and grounds, taking great pride in the
15 appearance of the building; now, therefore,

18 SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:



1 **Section 1.** Chapter 218 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:
3 *The Legislative Building in Carson City shall be known as the*
4 *Lawrence E. Jacobsen Legislative Building.*

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
