

SENATE BILL NO. 37—SENATOR WIENER

SUMMARY—Requires development of recommendations for elimination of obsolete or antiquated statutes. (BDR 17-115)

AN ACT relating to revision of statutes; requiring the development of biennial recommendations for the elimination of obsolete or antiquated statutes; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** Chapter 218 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
- 2     thereto a new section to read as follows:
- 3     *The Legislative Counsel and the Research Director shall work*
- 4     *collaboratively to develop recommendations for the elimination of*
- 5     *obsolete or antiquated provisions contained in the Nevada Revised*
- 6     *Statutes. The recommendations, if any, must be presented to the*
- 7     *Legislative Commission on or before July 1 of each even-*
- 8     *numbered year. The Legislative Commission shall, as it deems*
- 9     *appropriate, request the preparation of a bill draft to facilitate the*
- 10    *recommendations.*
- 11    **Sec. 2.** NRS 220.080 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 12    220.080 The Legislative Counsel shall, from time to time:
- 13    1. Make recommendations to the Legislature for clarification of
- 14    specific statutes.
- 15    2. ~~Make recommendations to the Legislature for elimination~~
- 16    ~~of obsolete statutes.~~
