SENATE BILL NO. 4-SENATOR RHOADS

- SUMMARY—Eliminates universal energy charge funding lowincome energy assistance and conservation programs. (BDR 58-40)

AN ACT relating to energy; eliminating the universal energy charge to fund low-income energy assistance and conservation; eliminating the provisions requiring certain retail customers to pay the universal energy charge; eliminating requirements upon certain public utilities and municipal utilities relating to the universal energy charge; eliminating the Fund for Energy Assistance and Conservation; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 703.130 is hereby amended to read as follows: 2 703.130 1. The Commission shall appoint a Deputy 3 Commissioner who shall serve in the unclassified service of the 4 State.

5 2. The Commission shall appoint a Secretary who shall 6 perform such administrative and other duties as are prescribed by 7 the Commission. The Commission shall also appoint an Assistant 8 Secretary.

9 3. The Commission may employ such other clerks, experts or 10 engineers as may be necessary.

11 4. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 5, the 12 Commission:



1 (a) May appoint one or more hearing officers for a period 2 specified by the Commission to conduct proceedings or hearings 3 that may be conducted by the Commission pursuant to [NRS 4 702.160 and 702.170 and] chapters 704, 704A, 704B, 705, 708 and 5 711 of NRS.

6 (b) Shall prescribe by regulation the procedure for appealing a 7 decision of a hearing officer to the Commission.

8 5. The Commission shall not appoint a hearing officer to 9 conduct proceedings or hearings:

(a) In any matter pending before the Commission pursuant to
 NRS 704.7561 to 704.7595, inclusive; or

(b) In any matter pending before the Commission pursuant to
NRS 704.061 to 704.110, inclusive, in which an electric utility has
filed a general rate application or an application to clear its deferred
accounts.

16 6. As used in this section, "electric utility" has the meaning 17 ascribed to it in NRS 704.187.

Sec. 2. NRS 703.147 is hereby amended to read as follows:

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19 703.147 1. The Public Utilities Commission Regulatory Fund is hereby created as a special revenue fund. Except as otherwise 20 provided in NRS [702.170 and] 704.7828, all money collected by 21 the Commission pursuant to law must be deposited in the State 22 23 Treasury for credit to the Fund. Money collected for the use of the Consumer's Advocate of the Bureau of Consumer Protection in the 24 25 Office of the Attorney General must be transferred pursuant to the 26 provisions of subsection 8 of NRS 704.035.

27 2. Money in the Fund which belongs to the Commission may 28 be used only to defray the costs of:

(a) Maintaining staff and equipment to regulate adequately
 public utilities and other persons subject to the jurisdiction of the
 Commission.

(b) Participating in all rate cases involving those persons.

(c) Audits, inspections, investigations, publication of notices,
 reports and retaining consultants connected with that regulation and
 participation.

36 (d) The salaries, travel expenses and subsistence allowances of37 the members of the Commission.

38 3. All claims against the Fund must be paid as other claims 39 against the State are paid.

40 4. The Commission [must] *shall* furnish upon request a 41 statement showing the balance remaining in the Fund as of the close 42 of the preceding fiscal year.

43 Sec. 3. NRS 703.164 is hereby amended to read as follows:

44 703.164 1. The Commission may employ, or retain on a 45 contract basis, legal counsel who shall:



1 (a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, [be] act as 2 counsel and attorney for the Commission in all actions, proceedings and hearings. 3

(b) Prosecute in the name of the Commission all civil actions for 4 the enforcement of [NRS 702.160 and 702.170 and] chapters 704, 5 704A, 704B, 705 and 708 of NRS and for the recovery of any 6 penalty or forfeiture provided for therein. 7

8 (c) Generally aid the Commission in the performance of its 9 duties and the enforcement of [NRS 702.160 and 702.170 and] 10 chapters 704, 704A, 704B, 705 and 708 of NRS.

2. Each district attorney shall: 11

(a) Prosecute any violation of chapter 704, 704A, 705, 708 or 12 711 of NRS for which a criminal penalty is provided and which 13 14 occurs in his county.

(b) Aid in any investigation, prosecution, hearing or trial held 15 under the provisions of chapter 704, 704A, 705, 708 or 711 of NRS 16 and, at the request of the Commission or its legal counsel, act as 17 counsel and attorney for the Commission. 18

3. The Attorney General shall, if the district attorney fails or 19 20 refuses to do so, prosecute all violations of the laws of this state by public utilities under the jurisdiction of the Commission and their 21 22 officers, agents and employees.

4. The Attorney General is not precluded from appearing in or 23 24 moving to intervene in any action and representing the interest of the State of Nevada in any action in which the Commission is a 25 26 party and is represented by independent counsel. 27

Sec. 4. NRS 703.197 is hereby amended to read as follows:

703.197 1. The Commission may collect fees for the filing of 28 any official document required by this chapter and chapters 704, 29 30 704A, 704B, 705 and 708 of NRS or by a regulation of the 31 Commission.

2. Filing fees may not exceed:

(a) For applications, \$200. 33

(b) For petitions seeking affirmative relief, \$200.

(c) For each tariff page which requires public notice and is not 35 attached to an application, \$10. If more than one page is filed at one 36 time, the total fee may not exceed the cost of notice and publication. 37 38

(d) For all other documents which require public notice, \$10.

3. If an application or other document is rejected by the 39 40 Commission because it is inadequate or inappropriate, the filing fee 41 must be returned.

42 4. The Commission may not charge any fee for filing [-

43 (a) A complaint.

44 (b) A request for a refund pursuant to <u>NRS 702.160.1</u> a

45 complaint.

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Sec. 5. NRS 702.010, 702.020, 702.030, 702.040, 702.050, 1 702.060, 702.070, 702.080, 702.090, 702.100, 702.110, 702.150, 2 702.160, 702.170, 702.250, 702.260, 702.270 and 702.280 are 3 4 hereby repealed. Sec. 6. Notwithstanding the amendatory provisions of this act, 5 the provisions of NRS 702.010 to 702.280, inclusive, 703.130, 6 7 703.147, 703.164 and 703.197 continue in force and effect for the purposes of: 8 9 1. Paying and enforcing the payment of all money required to 10 be paid pursuant to NRS 702.160 before July 1, 2003, until all such money has been paid; and 11

12 2. Distributing all money in the Fund for Energy Assistance 13 and Conservation until all such money has been distributed.

14 Sec. 7. This act becomes effective on July 1, 2003.
