AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Division of Mental Health and Developmental Services of the Department of Human Resources for an unanticipated shortfall in Fiscal Year 2002-2003 for a shortfall in revenue collections and expenditures relating to psychiatric services at rural clinics; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General  
2 Fund to the Division of Mental Health and Developmental Services  
3 of the Department of Human Resources the sum of \$740,598 for an  
4 unanticipated shortfall in money for Fiscal Year 2002-2003 for a  
5 shortfall in revenue collections and expenditures relating to  
6 psychiatric services at rural clinics. This appropriation is  
7 supplemental to that made by section 19 of chapter 570, Statutes of  
8 Nevada 2001, at page 2861.
