# THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General 1 Fund to the Division of Mental Health and Developmental Services 2 of the Department of Human Resources the sum of \$740,598 for an 3 unanticipated shortfall in money for Fiscal Year 2002-2003 for a 4 shortfall in revenue collections and expenditures relating to 5 psychiatric services at rural clinics. This appropriation is 6 supplemental to that made by section 19 of chapter 570, Statutes of 7 Nevada 2001, at page 2861. 8
