AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Department of Motor Vehicles for an unanticipated shortfall in money for Fiscal Year 2002-2003 resulting from increased postage rates and mailing requirements; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

# THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund to the Department of Motor Vehicles the sum of \$470,000 for an unanticipated shortfall in money for Fiscal Year 2002-2003 resulting from increased postage rates and mailing requirements. This appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 30 of chapter 570, Statutes of Nevada 2001, at page 2864. **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
