AN ACT relating to state financial administration; authorizing the University and Community College System of Nevada to carry forward 50 percent of the unexpended appropriations from one fiscal year to the following fiscal year; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** NRS 353.253 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2     353.253 1. Every agency, department and institution of the  
3 State of Nevada shall deposit all money received from the Federal  
4 Government, the counties or other sources ~~( )~~ in the State Treasury  
5 as provided in NRS 353.250 unless otherwise provided by law.  
6 These deposits must be made to work program accounts directly or  
7 to other budget accounts.  
8     2. Except for the balance in any proprietary fund and  
9 appropriated or authorized reserves, any balance remaining at the  
10 end of a fiscal year in a budget account of an agency, department or  
11 institution of the State of Nevada, whether or not authorized for



1 expenditure under a work program, reverts to the source of funding  
2 supporting the agency, department or institution. If that source of  
3 funding is federal money or a source of revenue the use of which is  
4 restricted by statute, then the balance may be authorized for  
5 expenditure under a work program for the subsequent fiscal year in  
6 accordance with the provisions of this chapter.

7 3. No provision of this chapter may be construed to authorize  
8 or direct the transfer, expenditure or reversion of any money  
9 received from the Federal Government contrary to the conditions  
10 upon which that money was received or to any federal law or  
11 regulation respecting the accountability therefor.

12 4. ~~{This section does}~~ *Subsections 1, 2 and 3 do* not apply to  
13 the Board of Regents of the University of Nevada and the Nevada  
14 State Museum. *The Board of Regents may carry forward 50*  
15 *percent of the remaining amount of any appropriation from the*  
16 *State General Fund to the University and Community College*  
17 *System of Nevada that was not expended in a fiscal year for*  
18 *expenditure in the following fiscal year.*

19 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
