SENATE BILL NO. 484–COMMITTEE ON NATURAL RESOURCES

- SUMMARY—Makes various changes concerning provisions relating to Garlic and Onion Growers' Advisory Board and certain assessments levied upon growers of garlic or onions. (BDR 49-1274)

EXPLANATION - Matter in *bolded italics* is new; matter between brackets [omitted material] is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to agriculture; revising the membership of the Garlic and Onion Growers' Advisory Board; eliminating the refund for certain assessments paid for growing and harvesting garlic or onions; revising the date by which a grower of garlic or onions must pay such an assessment; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. NRS 556.020 is hereby amended to read as follows:
556.020 1. The Garlic and Onion Growers' Advisory Board,
consisting of five members, is hereby created.

- 4 2. Two members of the Advisory Board must be:
- 5 (a) Citizens of the United States;
- 6 (b) Residents of the State of Nevada; and

7 (c) Garlic growers actively engaged in the growing and 8 producing of garlic in the State of Nevada who derive a substantial 9 portion of their annual income from growing garlic.

- 10 3. Two members of the Advisory Board must be:
- 11 (a) Citizens of the United States;
- 12 (b) Residents of the State of Nevada; and



1 (c) Onion growers actively engaged in the growing and 2 producing of onions in the State of Nevada who derive a substantial portion of their annual income from growing onions. 3 4

4. One member of the *Advisory* Board must be +

5 (a) A] *a* citizen of the United States [;] and *be*:

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6 (a) Actively engaged in the industry of processing garlic or 7 onions:

(b) A member of **[the American Dehydrated Onion and Garlic** 8 9 Association.] an association which represents the interests of persons actively engaged in the industry of processing garlic or 10 11 onions; or 12

(c) Actively engaged in the research of garlic or onions.

Sec. 2. NRS 556.070 is hereby amended to read as follows:

556.070 [1.] The Department shall, on or before August 1 of 14 15 each year, fix an annual special assessment not to exceed \$10 per acre to be levied upon all garlic and onions grown and harvested in 16 this state [.] for commercial use. The Department shall collect the 17 assessment and transmit the proceeds to the State Treasurer for 18 19 credit to the Garlic and Onion Research and Promotion Account.

20 On or before June 30 of each year, any person who has paid the special assessment levied pursuant to this section may file a 21 22 claim for a refund with the Department accompanied by a receipt showing payment. Upon verification of the correctness of the claim, 23 the Department shall transmit the claim to the State Controller for 24 payment from the Garlic and Onion Research and Promotion 25 26 Account.] 27

Sec. 3. NRS 556.080 is hereby amended to read as follows:

28 556.080 All assessments levied pursuant to the provisions of NRS 556.070 must be [paid] : 29

30 1. *Paid* to the Department by the grower of garlic or onions 31 [and must be paid] ; and

32 2. *Paid* by December 1 of each year for the grower of garlie, 33 and by May 1 of each year for the grower of onions, or within 30 days after the planting of garlic or onions after those dates.] garlic 34 or onions harvested within the 12 months immediately preceding 35 36 that date.

Sec. 4. NRS 556.090 is hereby amended to read as follows:

38 556.090 Any grower who fails [to file a return or] to pay any assessment pursuant to NRS 556.070 [within the period] by 39 40 December 1 of each year as required by NRS 556.080 forfeits to the 41 Department a penalty of 5 percent of the amount of the assessment 42 due and 1 percent of the assessment due for each month of delay or 43 fraction thereof after [the end of the month in which the return was 44 required to be filed or in which] December 31 of the year that the assessment became due. The Department, if satisfied the delay was 45



excusable, may remit any part of the penalty. The penalty must be paid to the Department and deposited for credit to the Garlic and 1 2 Onion Research and Promotion Account. 3

Sec. 5. NRS 561.423 is hereby amended to read as follows: 561.423 1. The Garlic and Onion Research and Promotion 5 Account is hereby created in the State General Fund. The proceeds 6 of the special assessment levied pursuant to NRS 556.070 must be 7

credited to the Account . [and all refunds made pursuant to NRS 8

556.070 must be paid from the Account.] 9 10

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2. Expenditures from the Account may be made only for:

(a) Garlic and onion research programs and marketing-11 12 promotion programs;

(b) Administrative, per diem and travel expenses of the Garlic 13 and Onion Growers' Advisory Board; and 14

- (c) Reimbursement to the Department for administrative 15 expenses of the Department, not to exceed 5 percent of the 16 assessments collected. 17
- Sec. 6. This act becomes effective on July 1, 2003. 18
