AN ACT relating to the Legislature; requiring each regular session of the Legislature to adjourn sine die not later than midnight on the 120th calendar day of that session; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 218 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

The Legislature shall adjourn sine die each regular session not later than midnight of the 120th calendar day of that session.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
