AN ACT relating to public safety; requiring the driver of a vehicle entering or exiting a controlled-access highway to yield to vehicles traveling on the highway; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. NRS 484.322 is hereby amended to read as follows: 484.322 [1.] The driver of a vehicle about to enter or exit a controlled-access highway shall yield the right-of-way to all 2 3 vehicles approaching on the highway whose proximity constitutes 4 5 an immediate hazard and shall continue to yield the right-of-way to that traffic until the driver may proceed with reasonable safety. 6 7 [2. A driver of a vehicle who has yielded the right of way as required by subsection 1 may proceed to enter or exit the highway 8 9 and the drivers of all other vehicles approaching on the highway

10 shall yield the right-of way to vehicles entering or exiting the 11 highway.]
