AN ACT relating to regional planning; reducing the number of meetings that the Board of the Southern Nevada Regional Planning Coalition is required to hold; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 9 of chapter 489, Statutes of Nevada 1999, 1 as amended by chapter 255, Statutes of Nevada 2001, at page 1135, 2 3 is hereby amended to read as follows: Sec. 9. 1. The Board shall meet [each month] once every 2 months at a time and place designated by the 4 5 Chairman of the Board. The Board may hold special meetings 6 as often as the needs of the Board require, upon notice to each 7 8 member of the Board. 9 2. The Board shall provide notice of a meeting in the 10 manner prescribed by NRS 241.020. 3. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 4 and 11 NRS 241.0355: 12 13 (a) A majority of the members of the Board constitutes a 14 quorum; and



(b) All actions must be adopted by at least a majority of the members present and constituting the quorum at such a 1 2 3 meeting. 4. The affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the members of the Board is necessary to pass an action relating 4 5 6 to: (a) A budgetary matter or a matter which involves an expenditure of public money; or
(b) A contract or other instrument that creates a binding 7 8 9 legal obligation on a public entity. 10 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective on July 1, 2003. 11

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
