AN ACT making an appropriation for maintenance of the statewide system for the collection and analysis of information concerning birth defects and other adverse birth outcomes; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General 1 Fund to the Health Division of the Department of Human Resources 2 for maintenance of the statewide system for the collection and 3 analysis of information concerning birth defects and other adverse 4 5 birth outcomes established pursuant to NRS 442.320: For the fiscal year 2003-2004 \$150,000 6 For the fiscal year 2004-2005 \$150,000 7 Sec. 2. Any balance of the sums appropriated by section 1 of 8 this act remaining at the end of the respective fiscal years must not 9 be committed for expenditure after June 30 of the respective fiscal 10 years and reverts to the State General Fund as soon as all payments 11 12 of money committed have been made.

13 Sec. 3. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
