ADJOURNMENT SINE DIE

- 1. The Legislature shall not take any action on a bill or resolution after midnight Pacific Daylight Time on the 120th calendar day of session.
- 10 2. A Legislator shall not take any action to impede the progress of the Legislature in completing its business by the time 11 12 specified in subsection 1.
- 3. Any action taken in violation of subsection 2 shall be 14 deemed out of order.
