SENATE RESOLUTION—Inducting Warren L. “Snowy” Monroe into the Senate Hall of Fame.

- 1 WHEREAS, The Senate of the Legislature of the State of Nevada
2 has established a Senate Hall of Fame whose members are selected
3 by leadership from those past Senators who have served with
4 distinction and who have made exemplary contributions to the State
5 of Nevada; and
6 WHEREAS, Warren L. Monroe, fondly known as “Snowy” by his
7 friends and colleagues, served three terms in the Nevada Assembly
8 and in 1958 was elected to the Senate where he served nine
9 consecutive sessions for a total of 24 years of service in the
10 Legislature; and
11 WHEREAS, Warren Monroe’s years as a Senator included five
12 terms on the Senate Judiciary Committee, four of those as
13 Chairman, and five terms on the Transportation Committee, serving
14 as Chairman in 1965 on that committee’s predecessor, the Aviation,
15 Transportation, and Highways Committee; and
16 WHEREAS, During his legislative service, Warren Monroe was
17 instrumental in the development of the program for state historical
18 markers, the adoption of the Uniform Commercial Code and the
19 establishment of the Commission on Peace Officers’ Standards and
20 Training; and
21 WHEREAS, After decades of involvement with the *Humboldt*
22 *Star* and the *Elko Independent* newspapers, Warren Monroe was



1 honored with the Silver Makeup Rule Award presented by the
2 Nevada State Press Association in recognition of his longtime
3 service to the business, the State and his community, and it was this
4 award that earned him posthumous induction into the Nevada
5 Newspaper Hall of Fame upon its resurrection in 1998; and

6 WHEREAS, Warren Monroe was named "Distinguished
7 Nevadan" in 1986, and was known for his colorful personality that
8 brightened the day for everyone with whom he came in contact;
9 now, therefore, be it

10 RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, That
11 Warren L. Monroe, who dedicated his life to the best interests of the
12 people of Nevada, is hereby inducted into the Senate Hall of Fame
13 of the Legislature of the State of Nevada.
