

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 277—ASSEMBLYMAN HETTRICK

SUMMARY—Revises certain presumptions relating to abandoned vehicles. (BDR 43-1041)

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AN ACT relating to vehicles; revising the provisions concerning the responsibility of the registered owner of an abandoned vehicle; requiring the Department of Motor Vehicles to take certain actions relating to the removal of an abandoned vehicle; requiring the Department, under certain circumstances, to suspend the license and registration of a person who abandons a vehicle; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1       **Section 1.** NRS 487.220 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2       487.220 1. Every person who abandons a vehicle is  
3       responsible for the cost of removal and disposition of such vehicle.  
4       2. An abandoned vehicle is presumed to have been abandoned  
5       by the registered owner thereof. The registered owner may not rebut  
6       this presumption by showing that **He**:  
7           (a) **He** transferred his interest in the abandoned vehicle unless  
8       he complied with the provisions set forth in NRS 482.399 to  
9       482.420, inclusive **or**; or  
10          (b) **The vehicle was stolen from him unless he submits evidence that, before the discovery of the vehicle, he filed an affidavit with the Department of Motor Vehicles or a written report with an appropriate law enforcement agency alleging the theft of the vehicle.**



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1       3. Unless:

2           (a) The registered owner of the abandoned vehicle rebuts the  
3 presumption that he is the registered owner pursuant to subsection  
4 2; or

5           (b) The vehicle is removed pursuant to NRS 487.230,  
6 the Department shall, as soon as practicable after becoming  
7 aware of the abandoned vehicle, submit a written notice to the  
8 registered owner stating that he must remove the vehicle within 30  
9 days after the date the Department issues the notice. If the  
10 registered owner fails to remove the vehicle within that period, the  
11 Department shall remove the vehicle.

12       4. If the Department removes an abandoned vehicle pursuant  
13 to subsection 3, or if the vehicle is removed pursuant to NRS  
14 487.230 and the registered owner of the vehicle fails to reclaim the  
15 vehicle within the period specified in NRS 487.250 or 487.270, the  
16 Department shall revoke the driver's license of the registered  
17 owner and the certificate of registration of any vehicle registered  
18 by the owner pursuant to chapter 482 of NRS. The Department  
19 may, in accordance with any regulations adopted pursuant to NRS  
20 483.495, reinstate the driver's license and the certificate of  
21 registration of any of those vehicles if the registered owner:

22           (a) Pays the cost of removal and disposition of the abandoned  
23 vehicle; and

24           (b) Satisfies any lien placed on the abandoned vehicle  
25 pursuant to NRS 487.270.
