AN ACT relating to wildlife; requiring the Board of Wildlife Commissioners to establish by regulation an additional drawing for game tags for certain persons; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** Chapter 502 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:
3 1. *In addition to any drawing conducted pursuant to NRS*
4 *502.175 or 502.250, the Commission shall by regulation establish*
5 *a drawing for game tags, which may be entitled the Pioneers*
6 *Drawing. A person may participate in the drawing if, at the time*
7 *he submits his application for a tag, he:*
8 (a) *Is at least 66 years of age; and*
9 (b) *Has been a resident of this State for at least 25 years.*
10 2. *Each applicant for a tag pursuant to this section must pay:*
11 (a) *The applicable fees for submitting his application pursuant*
12 *to NRS 502.250 and 502.253; and*
13 (b) *If he is awarded a tag pursuant to this section, the*
14 *applicable fee for the issuance of the tag pursuant to*
15 *NRS 502.250.*



1 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2005.
