Amend section 1, page 2, line 24, by deleting “*Sell*,” and inserting:

“*Make recommendations to the governing body of the city to sell*,”.

Amend the title of the bill, second line, after “to” by inserting:

“make recommendations to the governing body of the city to”.

Amend the summary of the bill to read as follows:

“SUMMARY—Authorizes appointed trustees of city library to make recommendations to governing body of city to sell, exchange, transfer, assign or otherwise dispose of real or personal property of library. (BDR 33-509)”.

**If this amendment is adopted, the Legislative  
Counsel's Digest will be changed to read as follows:**

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

Existing law requires the governing body of a city to determine whether to be the governing authority of the city library or to appoint a board of trustees to fill that role. If a board of trustees is appointed, the appointed trustees are required to perform certain acts to establish, maintain and manage the library. The appointed trustees are also authorized to perform certain acts necessary for the management and control of the library. (NRS 379.105)

This bill expands the authority of the appointed trustees of a city library to include making recommendations to the governing body of the city regarding the sale, exchange, transfer, assignment or other disposal of any real or personal property owned by the library or in which the library has an interest.
