*“injured [-] and to conduct any reinterment or redeposit for which costs were ordered pursuant to subsection 1.”.*

Amend sec. 7, page 4, line 9, after “(c);” by inserting “*or*”.

Amend the title of the bill, first line, by deleting “cemeteries;” and inserting “crimes;”.
