## Counsel's Digest will be changed to read as follows:

## **Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

Existing law establishes the requirements for occupational education in public schools within the State. (NRS 388.330-388.400)

This bill redesignates occupational education as career and technical education. This bill requires the State Board for Occupational Education to prescribe a program of career and technical education for pupils enrolled in grades 9 through 12. This bill authorizes school districts and charter schools to establish and maintain a program of career and technical education in accordance with the Board's program.

A pupil who successfully completes a program of career and technical education may be awarded a career and technical education advanced diploma or, at the discretion of the pupil, another type of diploma for which the pupil is otherwise eligible. If a pupil does not satisfy the requirements for a career and technical education advanced diploma, but otherwise satisfies the requirements for graduation from high school, the pupil must be awarded a standard high school diploma.

This bill appropriates \$12 million over the next 2 fiscal years to the Department of Education for allocations to school districts and charter schools to provide a program of career and technical education. The amount of an allocation to a school district or charter school whose application is approved must be based on the estimated number of pupils who will participate in the program for that fiscal year and the financial need of the school district or charter school.
