**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

Under existing law, the Department of Motor Vehicles consists of seven specific divisions. (NRS 481.0473)

This bill adds the Motor Carrier Division as a division of the Department of Motor Vehicles.

7      4. A Division of Central Services and Records;  
8      5. A Division of Management Services and Programs;  
9      6. A Division of Information Technology; **[and]**  
10     7. An Administrative Services Division **[; and]**
