SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing compensation for Board of Regents of University of Nevada. (BDR 34-774)

AN ACT relating to the University and Community College System of Nevada; providing for a salary for members of the Board of Regents of the University of Nevada for attending meetings; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

- 1 Existing law provides that members of the Board of Regents of the University
2 of Nevada serve without a salary. (NRS 396.070)
3 This bill entitles a member of the Board of Regents to receive a salary of \$80
4 and the Chairman of the Board to receive a salary of \$85 for attendance at each
5 meeting of the Board.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 396.070 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 396.070 1. ~~[A]~~ *Except for the salary of the Chairman, each*
3 member of the Board of Regents is ~~[not]~~ entitled to receive ~~[any~~
4 ~~compensation for his services.]~~ *a salary of \$80 for each meeting of*
5 *the Board that he attends.*
6 2. *The Chairman of the Board of Regents is entitled to*
7 *receive a salary of \$85 for each meeting of the Board that he*
8 *attends.*



1 **3.** Each member of the Board of Regents is entitled to receive
2 in attending meetings of the Board, or while on Board of Regents'
3 business within the State:

4 (a) A per diem expense allowance not to exceed the greater of:

5 (1) The rate of \$60; or

6 (2) The maximum rate established by the Federal
7 Government for the locality in which the travel is performed.

8 (b) A travel allowance computed at the rate provided for state
9 officers and employees generally in subsection 3 of NRS 281.160.

10 **Sec. 2.** NRS 396.080 is hereby amended to read as follows:

11 396.080 The Board of Regents shall have the power to appoint
12 a Chairman . ~~[, who shall receive no compensation for his services~~
13 ~~as Chairman.]~~

14 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2005.
