AN ACT relating to the University and Community College System of Nevada; providing for a salary for members of the Board of Regents of the University of Nevada for attending meetings; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

- 1 Existing law provides that members of the Board of Regents of the University
2 of Nevada serve without compensation. (NRS 396.070)
3 This bill entitles each member of the Board of Regents to receive a salary of
4 \$80 for attendance at each meeting of the Board.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 396.070 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 396.070 1. **[A] Each** member of the Board of Regents is
3 **[not]** entitled to receive **[any compensation for his services.] a**
4 ***salary of \$80 for each meeting of the Board that he attends.***
5 2. Each member of the Board of Regents is entitled to receive
6 in attending meetings of the Board, or while on Board of Regents'
7 business within the State:
8 (a) A per diem expense allowance not to exceed the greater of:
9 (1) The rate of \$60; or

1 (2) The maximum rate established by the Federal
2 Government for the locality in which the travel is performed.

3 (b) A travel allowance computed at the rate provided for state
4 officers and employees generally in subsection 3 of NRS 281.160.

5 **Sec. 2.** NRS 396.080 is hereby amended to read as follows:

6 396.080 The Board of Regents shall have the power to appoint
7 a Chairman. ~~[, who shall receive no compensation for his services
8 as Chairman.]~~

9 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2005.
