SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing operation of taxicabs in certain counties. (BDR 58-919)

AN ACT relating to transportation; revising provisions governing the maximum period that a vehicle may be used as a taxicab in certain counties; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law establishes the Taxicab Authority, which regulates the taxicab
2 industry in counties whose population is 400,000 or more (currently Clark County)
3 and in any county that has established by ordinance the jurisdiction of the Taxicab
4 Authority within the county. (NRS 706.881-706.885) Existing law specifies
5 the maximum period that a vehicle may be used as a taxicab in those counties.
6 (NRS 706.8834)
7 This bill clarifies the method for calculating the maximum period that a vehicle
8 may be used as a taxicab. This bill also gives a taxicab operator 90 days in which to
9 remove a vehicle from operation after it has been used as a taxicab for the
10 maximum period.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 706.8834 is hereby amended to read as
2 follows:
3 706.8834 1. **[A] If a vehicle used by a** certificate holder
4 **[shall not permit a vehicle to be used]** as a taxicab **[if it]** has been in
5 operation as a taxicab for **[more than]** 4 model years or 52 months
6 **[, based on its vehicle identification number or the date it was**

1 **originally placed into operation as a taxicab**, whichever period is
2 longer **H, the certificate holder:**

3 **(a) Shall remove the vehicle from operation as a taxicab within
4 90 days; and**

5 **(b) Shall not permit the vehicle to be used as a taxicab in the
6 operations of the certificate holder at any time thereafter.**

7 2. Any vehicle which a certificate holder acquires for use as a
8 taxicab must:

9 (a) Be new; or

10 (b) Register not more than 30,000 miles on the odometer.

11 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2005.
